

Minutes of the Meeting of the Common Council of the City of Chetek held on Tuesday, June 11, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chamber, 220 Stout Street, Chetek, WI

Meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m. Clerk/treasurer, Carmen Newman, took roll call.

Present: Cliff Bronstad, Bill Waite, Dianne Knowlton, Mike Linton, Shirley Morley

Agenda approval: Bronstad motioned to approve – second by Linton. Carried.

Linton motioned to approve the consent agenda items, second by Waite. May council minutes and claims, liquor/fermented malt beverage licenses – Red’s, Mary’s, R&L Indianhead, B&B, Stringer’s, Kwik Trip, Chetek Express, Keg n’ Kork, Gordy’s, VFW, American Legion, Temporary Class “B” license for Vintage Voyagers. Carried.

Accept and place on file minutes: Knapp Haven May 16th, Housing Authority April 25th, Library May 7th – motion by Bronstad, second by Morley. Carried.

Accept and place on file building inspection report for May – motion by Linton, second by Waite. Carried.

Motion by Waite, second by Bronstad to approve Resolution 2013-14 – review of the 2012 Compliance Maintenance Annual Report. Carried.

Linton made a motion to have clerk/treasurer, Carmen Newman, send a letter to the railroad commissioner regarding the condition of the railroad crossings in Chetek and copy the legislators, Progressive Railroad, Barron County and Chetek-Weyerhaeuser Schools. Second by Bronstad. Carried.

Motion by Bronstad to approve employees’ annual requests for outside employment. Second by Linton. Carried.

Bronstad motioned to approve Red’s requests for outdoor premise description changes on their liquor license for weekend events as filed. Second by Waite. Carried.

Waite motioned to approve Gregarson Homemaker’s request to use Main Street Park pavilion on July 4th for fundraising event. Second by Morley – carried.

Motion by Waite to approve stop sign placement on 15th Street at intersection of 15th & Center Street; Lakeview Drive west bound at Wisconsin Avenue; and four way stop at First Street and Knapp Street. Second by Morley. Carried

Bronstad motioned to approve speed limit change on Railroad Avenue from Knapp to Dallas down from 30 mph to 25mph – second by Linton. Carried.

Bronstad motioned to approve speed limit change on Railroad Avenue from Dallas to Ross road from 35mph down to 25 mph – second by Linton. Carried.

Linton motioned to approve Resolution 2013-10 appropriating money donated by Dr. Ivan Sletten for the summer music program. Second by Bronstad – carried.

Linton motioned to draft letter from council members requesting Impact Seven to enter into an agreement for payment in lieu of tax for Barc-Lane building. Second by Waite. Carried.

Bronstad motioned to adjourn – second by Linton. Carried
