MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHETEK HELD ON TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2015 AT 6:00 P.M. IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBER, CHETEK CITY HALL, 220 STOUT STREET.

Mayor Mike Linton presiding.

Meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m. Roll call was taken.

Council Members Present: Bill Waite, Mark Edwards, Shirley Morley Absent: Cliff Bronstad

The property on which Knapp Haven/Pelican Place nursing home and assisted living units are located is currently zoned R3- multi family residence. The operating of a nursing home, under current zoning regulations, requires a conditional use. With the upcoming sale of the nursing home, the creation of a new zoning district will ensure and properly document that the property is in compliance with the City zoning regulations. Edwards motioned to adopt amendment to text regulation creating R-4 High Density Personal Care Housing District for the property on which the Knapp Haven nursing home and Pelican Place assisted living units currently are located. 2nd by Morley. Carried.

Council discussed acquiring tablets for use at meetings and receiving packet information, etc. Clerk/treasurer, Carmen Newman, advised that Verizon had a sale on tablets with the cost being credited back with the purchase of monthly data. The cost was \$10 per month per tablet for 5 gigs of data. If the sale is no longer in effect she will pursue other options. Waite motioned to proceed with the purchase of tablets – if the sale is no longer in effect, the cost options will be brought back to council members. 2^{nd} by Edwards. Carried.

Garbage rate schedule was discussed. An increase effective November 1, 2015 is being proposed. Utility committee approved the proposed increase. The residential rates would increase from \$19 to \$21 monthly and the senior rates would increase from \$15 to \$16 monthly. The commercial rates will be \$20.00 per weekly pickup plus \$10 per yard picked up weekly. Example: a 2 yard dumpster picked up once per week will cost \$40.00. Previous extra light charge was \$32. Commercial accounts are being reviewed for actual dumpster sizes and number of pickups per week. Edwards motioned to approve the rate increase for garbage service. 2nd by Morley. Carried.

Morley approved the carryover of 78 hours of vacation time for Carmen Newman. Vacation hours will be used by year end. 2^{nd} by Edwards. Carried.

Motion to adjourn by Edwards, 2nd by Waite. Carried.
