Jeff Martin reported on city happenings as the city council representative.

The board reviewed a form that patrons can file to any appeal library charges. Motion was made by Nancy Nix, seconded by Louise Brown, to approve the form as printed. Motion carried.

Resendiz updated the board on two staff openings that have arisen because of retirement. This also prompted discussion on wages and how to move forward with filling the two openings. Rachel Westberg made a motion to provide \$100 in Chetek Chamber Bucks to retiree Gail Frye in honor of her decades of service to the library and the city. Motioned seconded by Jeff Martin. Motion carried.

Items for the April meeting include an update on staffing, salary and wages, and the summer reading program.
